The *Stock Package Shipping Sendcloud Module* allows package labels to be generated for shipments made by any of [Sendcloud's](#) supported carriers.

CONFIGURATION

The *Stock Package Shipping Sendcloud Module* uses values from settings in the [stock_package_shipping_sendcloud] section of the [configuration file](#).

1.1 addresses_cache

The `addresses_cache` defines the duration in seconds the sender addresses are kept in the cache.

The default value is: 15 * 60.

1.2 shipping_methods_cache

The `shipping_methods_cache` defines the duration in seconds the shipping methods are kept in the cache.

The default value is: 60 * 60.

1.3 requests_timeout

The `requests_timeout` defines the time in seconds the module is waiting for a response from the Sendcloud server.

The default value is: 300.

The *Stock Package Shipping Sendcloud Module* introduces the following concepts:

2.1 Sendcloud Credential

This is used to store the credentials needed to connect to the Sendcloud API. It also defines the sender address for each warehouse and the shipping method for each carrier.

Note: For carriers without a shipping method, the Sendcloud rules are applied.

2.2 Carrier

When the *Stock Package Shipping Sendcloud Module* is activated, carriers gain some extra properties. These include a new shipping service “Sendcloud” and a label format.
